OVERVIEW

The Contemporary Dayton (formerly the Dayton Visual Arts Center) is accepting applications for approximately 20 artworks to be purchased or commissioned for permanent display. Artwork can be any type of wall hung artwork, EXCEPT photography-based work, i.e. low relief wall sculpture, painting, drawing, printmaking. The approximate size of the final artworks will no smaller than 24 x 36 and no larger than 40 x 40 in. (framed). The theme for all artwork is **Things That Fly.**

OPTION 1: Existing work that fits the theme.

OPTION 2: Proposal of new work.

AWARDS & BUDGET

Price points for existing or newly created work should be between \$250-\$3,000 each. The Contemporary Dayton will NOT take a commission on work.

THEME

All design concepts should explore the theme of *Things That Fly*, i.e. birds, planes, kites, dandelion seeds, flying carpets, etc. The design or designs can be reflective of a narrative representation or abstraction of the overarching theme. We are looking for colorful, inspiring, and engaging interpretations of the theme. Please review the attached inspiration images for more ideas.

- Up to 4 examples of existing works, and 2-4 sketches/designs for proposed new work(s) and 1-2 sentence description, including estimated date of completed work i.e. April 1, or June 1, etc.
